## DR. & MRS. CHARLES S. SWOPE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION

## APPLICATION

A Memorial Scholarship Trust Fund has been established in the memory of Dr. and Mrs. Charles S. Swope, President of West Chester University for a quarter of a century, by his family and friends. Each year the Foundation awards scholarships between \$1,000 - \$3,000 to students of West Chester University who meet the following criteria:

- 1. Undergraduate students must be enrolled in a full time academic program, must have completed at least <u>45 credit</u> <u>hours at West Chester University</u> at the time of the application, and
  - a. accumulated no more than 89.5 credits toward graduation at the time of the application OR
  - b. applied with the West Chester University Registrar's office for graduation no sooner than the calendar year following the year of the application. (For example, an application for a Swope Scholarship submitted in April of 2015 would have had to apply for graduation no sooner than spring, summer or fall of calendar year 2016).

Applicants must have <u>minimum grade point average of 3.5 (as of the end of Fall 2014 semester)</u>.

- 2. Graduate students must be enrolled in a full time program (minimum 9 credits) and must have <u>received their</u> baccalaureate degree from West Chester University.
- 3. All applicants must be *U.S. citizens* and have permanent residence in the U.S.A.

To apply for this award, the applicants meeting the above criteria must provide the following:

- 1. <u>One (1) letter of recommendation</u> from a West Chester University faculty member who address academic performance.
- 2. <u>One (1) letter of recommendation</u> from a community leader who can address applicant's community involvement, leadership qualities and citizenship qualities. This must be printed on the community leader's letterhead (cannot be WCU letterhead).
- 3. A curriculum vita or resume, especially noting community involvement and service.
- 4. A completed *application*.

The Foundation will award the scholarships primarily on the basis of scholastic achievement. Consideration will be given to community and/or university involvement of the applicant, in addition to how the applicant contributes to the Swope Legacy. The Foundation will notify recipients of their award in July by mail. Funds will be available to begin class in September.

The Swope Legacy to West Chester University, summarized from The Swope Legacy, an autobiography of Charles E. Swope

Charles S. Swope, an alumnus of the West Chester University class of 1921, became President of West Chester University at the age of thirty-five. He was appointed by Governor Earle following a serious financial crisis at the institution.

Charles and wife, Edna, were both graduates of the class of 1921 and dedicated their lives to the enrichment of West Chester University, known as West Chester State Teachers College during this time. Swope's vision for the University included a Master Plan which proposed many of the buildings that comprise the campus today.

Charles E., son of Charles S. and Edna, went on to become President of the Board of Trustees and complete his parents vision of growth and physical expansion of the University. In the early 1960's stalled building projects were reenergized and construction commenced with the support of Governor Scranton.

Following the death of Charles S. in 1959, Edna and their two sons, Charles and Richard, formed The Swope Foundation in 1960. The Swope Foundation has supported West Chester University students for over fifty years and has provided nearly One Million Dollars in scholarship funds.
